What will you have to pay us for this service?

We arrange the policy with the Insurer on your behalf. You do not pay us a fee for arranging this service.

What we receive from your insurers

When we arrange or renew your policy, we are paid a flat fee from your insurer.

Payment

You are responsible for paying premiums by the due date. We have no obligation to fund premiums for you and have no responsibility for any loss you may suffer as a result of the insurer cancelling the policy due to non-payment.

We normally accept payment by debit or credit card or by way of monthly direct debit initiated at the point of sale.

Sending your policy documents

We send documents by electronic means to the email address you provide when you purchase cover. If you prefer to receive your documents through the post, please tick the box to receive your documents by post.

When your policy is due for renewal, we will remind you of your options relating to how we send documents to you.

To help support the environment, we encourage you to receive your documents electronically. This will help to reduce the use of paper, saving trees, and also reduces the use of printers, saving electricity.

Cancellation

You have the right to cancel your policy at any time. If a successful claim has been made against your policy, we may retain your full premium. If you haven't made a claim, we will provide a proportionate refund, based on the number of days you were covered.

If your policy is cancelled more than 14 days after you have received your policy documents, there will be a cancellation fee of £25.00 applied.

You may choose to pay by instalments. If, for example, you decide to cancel a policy or your insurer becomes insolvent, you will still be required to make the agreed repayments. If you do not continue to pay your instalments your insurance may be cancelled.

Protecting your money

We act as agent for the insurer when collecting and refunding premiums. This means that premiums are treated as being received by the insurer when we receive them. Premium refunds are treated as received by you only when paid to you.
